An Overview of the Challenge



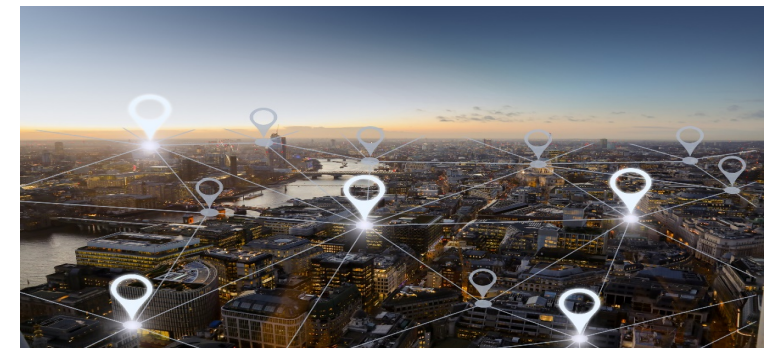
- Trends that describe current cargo theft parameters:
 - Most targeted commodities by cargo thieves are high value products easy to sell on the black market.
 - In some countries a rise in thefts of ‘high demand’ products is reported when they are no longer widely available.
 - Driver collusion continues to be a common threat for trucking companies.
 - Local law enforcement agencies (LLEA) report they lack sufficient personnel and funding.
 - Many cargo thieves pose as police officers.



Options to Reduce Risk



- Add delay in packaging/containerization of cargo
- Improve Information Security
- Use Reliable Transporters
- Operations in Warehousing & Distribution Centers
- Routing, scheduled fuel stops, and time schedule considerations
- Electronic Tracking Devices

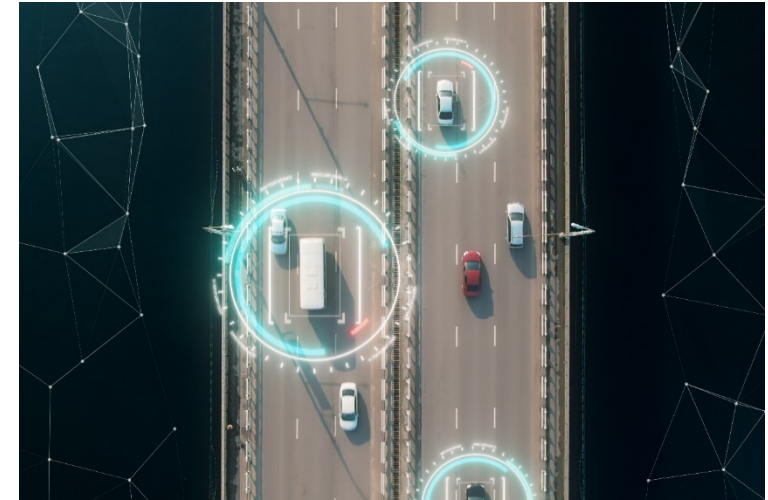
